## **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **1. RULES**

**1.1** The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

### **2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Windsail website, on the official King of the Vaal WhatsApp and DAC notice board no later than 18H00 on 24 January 2026 and will be available at registration.

### **3. COMMUNICATION**

**3.1** The official notice board is located at DAC Clubhouse notice board.

### **4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 4.1** The regatta is open to all keelboats that meet requirements (such as class regulations and safety equipment).
- 4.2** Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and submitting it, together with the fee, online at [www.windsail.co.za](http://www.windsail.co.za)
- 4.3** To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.4** Late entries will be accepted.

### **5. FEES**

Entry fees are as follows:

- R200.00 Full Youth Boat Entry
- R400.00 Normal Entry Fee

## **6. ADVERTISING**

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

## **7. SCHEDULE**

- 7.1 Registration: Sat 24/01/26, from 08H00 to 09H00.
- 7.2 Equipment inspection and event measurement may take place during the regatta.
- 7.3 Dates of racing: 24/01/2026 and 25/01/2026
- 7.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 12H30 24/01/26 and 10H00 on 25/01/26 – Incorporating the Middle of the Dam Series on the last day only.
- 7.5 A maximum of 6 races is scheduled.
- 7.6 On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 13H00.

## **8. MEASUREMENT**

- 8.1 Boats shall be available for equipment inspection during the regatta as may be required.

## **9. SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS**

- 9.1 Support person vessels shall be marked with a yellow flag.

## **10. PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows:

- 10.1 King of The Vaal – Overall winner on Handicap of the full Regatta
- 10.2 2nd Overall Winner
- 10.3 3rd Overall Winner
- 10.4 Further prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the race committee

## **11. RISK STATEMENT**

RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." Competitors participate in this event entirely at their own risk. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **12. INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of R1,5m per incident or the equivalent.
